mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Collect

P — Let us pray. *(brief pause)*

Grant, we pray, almighty God, that your faithful, who rejoice under the patronage of the most holy Virgin Mary, may be freed by her motherly intercession from all evils on earth and merit the attainment of eternal joys in heaven. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

First Reading

(Proverbs 8:22-31) *(Seated)*

A reading from the book of Proverbs

The wisdom of God says this: The Lord created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago. Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth. When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water. Before the mountains had been shaped, before the hills, I was brought forth—when he had not yet made earth and fields, or the world's first bits of soil. When the Lord established the heavens, I was there; when he drew a circle on the face of the deep, when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep, when he assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside the Lord, like a master worker; and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race.

Responsorial Psalm

(Luke 11:27-28)

P — A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke.

C — Glory to you, O Lord.

As Jesus was speaking to the people, a woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to him, "Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that nursed you!" But Jesus said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"

P — The Gospel of the Lord.

C — Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Homily *(Seated)*

Prayer of the Faithful

P — Our Blessed Mother, with great faith, responded to the sublime will of the Father. With confidence in her Motherly intercessions, we present our needs to God the Father. In every petition we say:

R — Lord, hear our prayer.

1. For the leaders of our Church: Pope Francis, the Bishops, Priests and Deacons, that with the intercessions of the Blessed Virgin Mary, they continue to grow in holiness and be filled with wisdom in the exercise of their priestly ministry: let us pray to the Lord. **(R)**
2. For the leaders of our country, that with the intercessions of our Blessed Mother, they may remain dedicated to their responsibilities for the attainment of unity, peace, and prosperity: let us pray to the Lord. **(R)**
3. For all the children, that they remain obedient to their parents and be led towards sanctity through Christian upbringing: let us pray to the Lord. **(R)**
4. For all of us gathered here, that through the guidance of our Ina, Our Lady of Peñafrancia, we may all sincerely offer to God our loving sacrifices and be worthy of the graces of the Sacraments that we receive: let us pray to the Lord. **(R)**

P — Our loving Father, may the love of our Blessed Mother continue to bring us closer to your Son. Hear our prayers and grant us the purity of heart and soul. Through Christ our Lord.

C — Amen.

LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

Offertory *(Seated)*

P — *(Stand)* Pray, brethren (brothers and sisters), that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

C — May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

Prayer over the Offerings

P — Look, O Lord, upon the prayers and offerings of your faithful, presented in commemoration of Blessed Mary, the Mother of God, that they may be pleasing to you and may confer on us your help and forgiveness. Through Christ our Lord.

C — Amen.

Preface I of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Through him the Angels praise your majesty, Dominions adore and Powers tremble before you. Heaven and the Virtues of heaven and the blessed Seraphim worship together with exultation. May our voices, we pray, join with theirs in humble praise, as we acclaim:

All — **Holy, Holy, Holy Lord God of hosts. Heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

Eucharistic Prayer *(Kneel)*

P — Mystery of Faith.

C — **We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.**

COMMUNION RITE

Lord's Prayer *(Stand)*

P — At the Savior's command...

All — **Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.**

P — Deliver us, Lord, we pray...

C — **For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.**

P — Lord Jesus Christ, who said...

C — Amen

Sign of Peace

P — The peace of the Lord be with you always.

C — **And with your spirit.**

P — Let us offer each other the sign of peace.

Lamb of God

All — **Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, grant us peace.**

Invitation to Communion *(Kneel)*

P — Behold the lamb of God...

All — **Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.**

Communion Antiphon (Cf. Lk 1: 48)

(Said when there is no Communion Hymn)

The Lord has looked on his lowly handmaid; behold, henceforth all generations will call me blessed.

Prayer after Communion *(Stand)*

P — Let us pray. *(brief pause)*

Renewed by the Sacrament of salvation, we humbly beseech you, Lord, that we, who have honored in veneration the memory of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of God, may merit to experience in perpetuity the fruits of your redemption. Through Christ our Lord.

B — Amen.

Prayer to the Virgin of Peñafrancia

All — Turn to me thine eyes, Oh most loving Virgin of Peñafrancia and have mercy on my soul that come to thee, full of repentance.

Protect my family, relatives, friends and benefactors. Intercede for your devotees, both the living and the dead, especially for those whom I am most obliged to help.

Pray for me, console me, save me. In my hours of peril, adversity and afflictions, above all, in the hour of my death, appear before your Divine Son to help and defend me. Tell Him that I am your devotee, that having complete trust in your protection I kneel before your miraculous image to ask for your powerful intercession.

Virgin of Peñafrancia, Pray for me, help me, console me, and deliver me from all evil. Amen.
